All the reclaimed Ballachulish states need to be hand dressed before they can be re-used. A major task for Tain Slating.



The slates are double-pinned to make a more secure fastening. The use of older slates means that they fit well with the rest of the building. And have the extra benefit of the beginnings of good lichen colonies.



To complete each section of the roof the gable capstones are replaced by the Laing Traditional Masonry team.

Inside the plaster work is still continuing. This is a beautifully crafted sample board by Andrew.
